Whenever and wherever we can we aim to offer you local produce. We offer delicious dishes on our menu using fresh local produce such as local herbs, local meat from local butchers, award winning Ice Cream from a local farm, local Cheese and freshly Baked Bread from our local bakers.

In addition to offering you fresh local produce we also believe in being ethically responsible whilst providing you with the best available product therefore, we have chosen a supplier for our tea and coffee that is Fairtrade, Organic and Rainforest Alliance certified. Whilst offering you delicious fish dishes we also believe it is important to purchase responsibly caught seafood, therefore we serve sustainable Cod on our menus from our local fishmonger.
